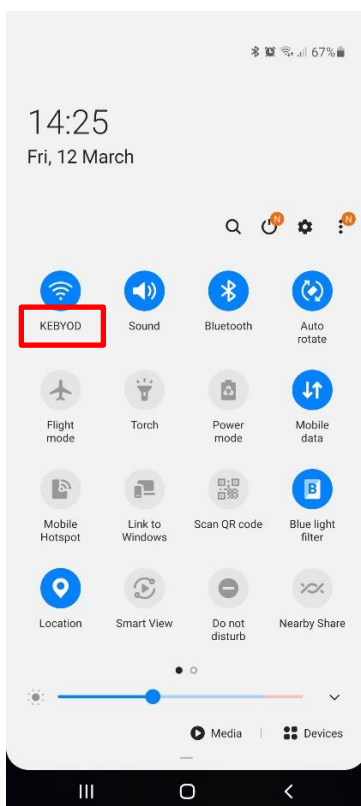
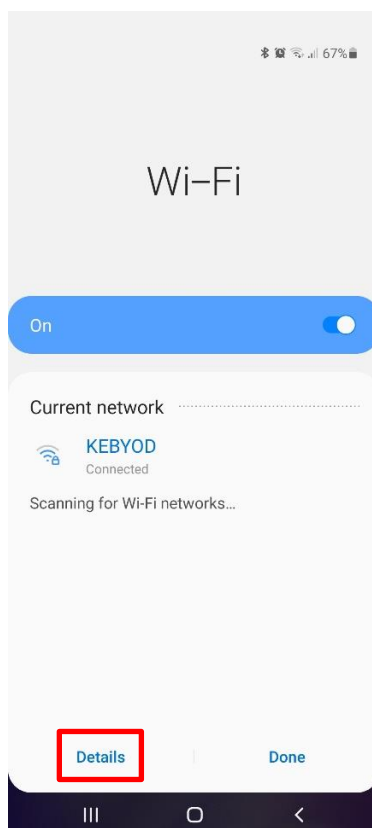


Forgetting and Reconnecting to KEYOD – Android.

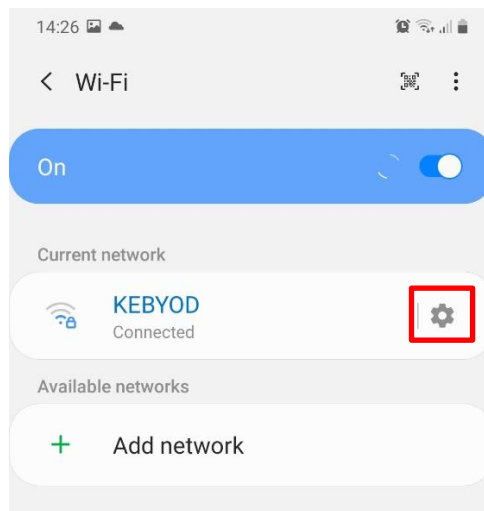
1. Drag your finger down from the top of your Android device to see your notification bar and quick options. Tap on the text of your current connection, highlighted below in red.



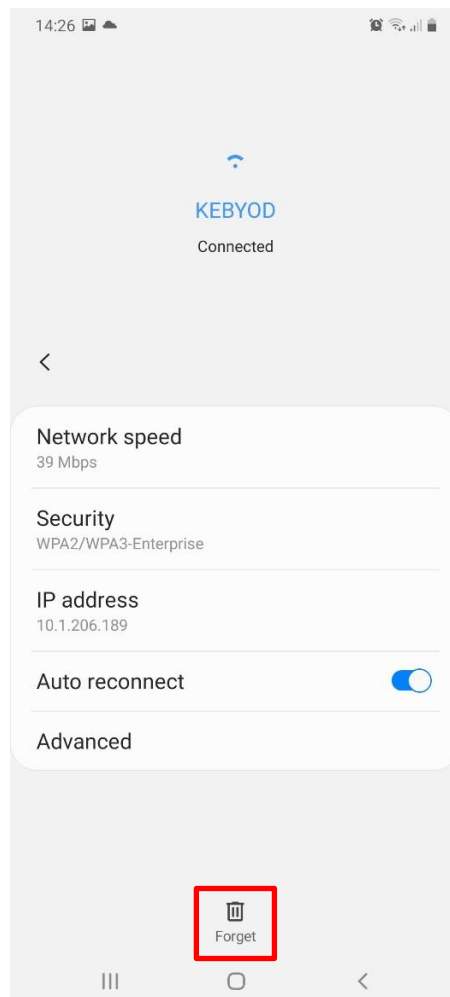
2. Tap on the **Details** button, highlighted below in red.



3. Tap on the **Cog** to the right of the **KEYBYOD** connection, highlighted below in red.

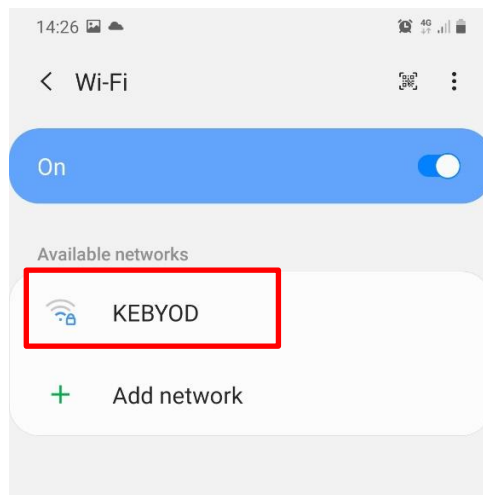


4. Tap the **Forget** button at the bottom of the page, highlighted below in red.

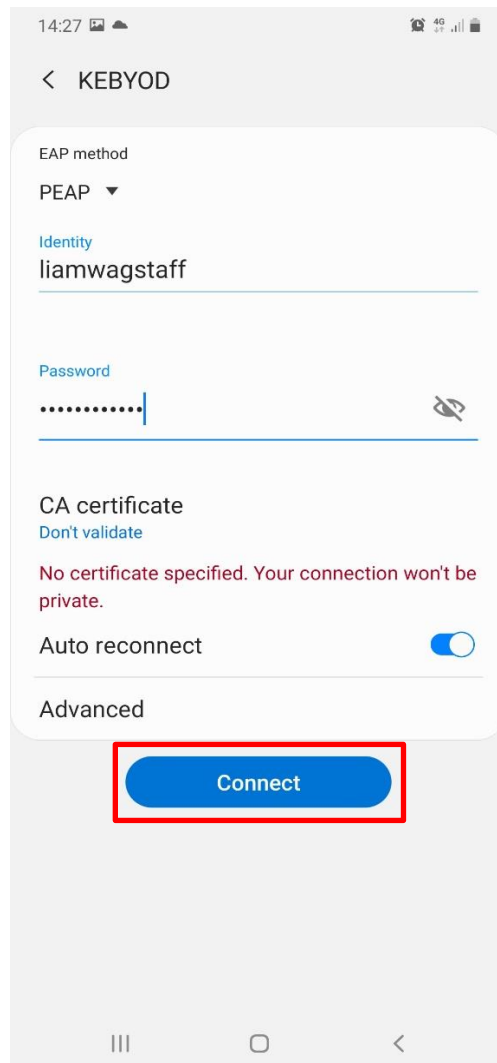


You have now forgotten all settings and information saved for the **KEYBYOD** connection.

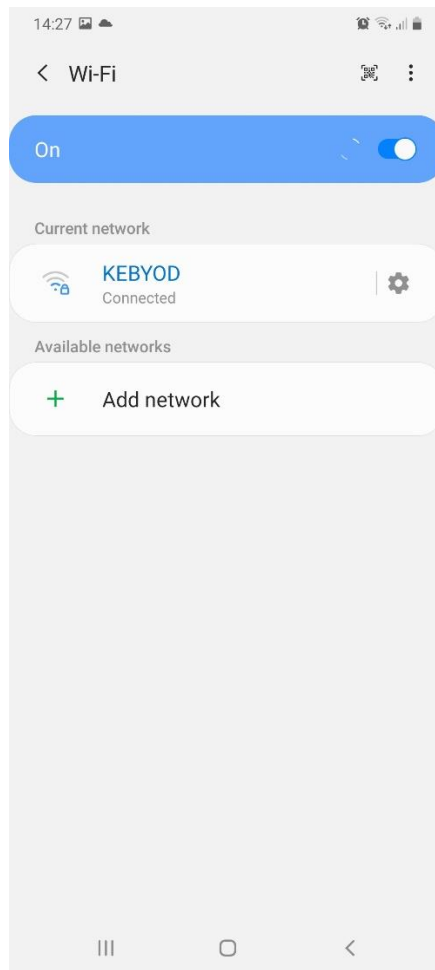
5. To reconnect, tap on **KEYBYOD** in the **Available networks** section, highlighted below in red.



6. **Match the settings** shown in the image below with the **Identity and Password** being the one you use to login to any school computer. Please make sure the CA certificate is set to 'Don't validate'.
7. Tap the **Connect** button, highlighted below in red.



If all the settings and login information was correct, you should see the **Connected** notification underneath the **KEYYOD** network.
